Prospective authors are kindly encouraged to contribute to and help shape the conference through submissions of their original and unpublished results of conceptual, constructive, empirical, experimental, and theoretical work in all areas of terminology. Thematic areas of TSTD 2022:

Topics of interest for submission include, but are not limited to:

- Terminology planning: the role of terminology in science and technology development; the role of terminology in education; the role of terminology for knowledge management and information systems
- Issues of modern terminology science and its manifold impacts and applications: linguistic and cognitive approaches, ontology; computational logic
- Standardization: terminology and standardization methodology; harmonizing terms and concepts; validating the quality of data; the role of experts; metadata and content, interoperability; certification issues
- Terminology and language technologies: term extraction; knowledge extraction; corpus technology; communication in assistive technologies; computer assisted translation; computational lexicography; new dimensions of speech technology; services of the language industry
- Terminology and other content resources: building and maintaining terminology resources, glossaries, dictionaries, thesauri, scientific nomenclatures and classifications; metadata and content integration
- New horizons: BigData or smart data? “Things” of the Internet of Things; product master data management; eAccessibility of websites or stores, etc.

General Requirements for the conference paper

- Papers should be fit within the scope of the conference theme.
- Authors are expected to submit papers that are original and have not been submitted to any other conferences and publications.
- Paper texts should be in Times New Roman using 12pt, single space in Microsoft Word with a length of no more than 30,000 characters (incl. spaces) and no more than 12 pages, if they comprise illustrations.
- Paper citation and references should follow APA.
- Papers should be in English and Mongolian.
